We NTT Electronics Corporation (NEL : Yokohama, Japan. Dr. Hiroshi Yoshimura, CEO & President) would like to inform you NEL existing status about influence of the earthquake and the response for it as follows.

* The state of affairs at NEL production

It was confirmed that several equipments and facilities at our Ibaraki factory are damaged. We also have confirmed that all NEL employees don't have serious damages. Continuously, our detail investigation for damaged equipments and facilities will be implemented in accordance with the condition of electricity power supply and the building itself.

Confirmed damages of production facilities are mentioned below.

- Ibaraki factory (Naka-shi, Ibaraki Prefecture)
- NEL Crystal Corporation (Futaba-gun, Fukushima Prefecture)

* The status of NEL employees

The disaster condition of NEL employees and the families are kept on confirming continuously.

* Establishment of NEL Measures Headquarter for tremendous earthquake.
